Mass General Brigham (MGB) Scholarship



Through a grant-funded partnership with Mass General Brigham (MGB), William James College (WJC) will provide annual scholarships and/or stipends to qualified alumni of the Behavioral Health Service Corps who are admitted to a graduate degree program (e.g., Master's in Counseling & Behavioral Health) at WJC.

As part of the College's mission to expand and diversify the behavioral health workforce, the BHSC Scholarships & Stipends Program is intended to recruit, train, mentor, and retain providers from culturally diverse and historically marginalized communities who are committed to serving individuals, families, and groups in underserved communities.

Qualified applicants will receive an annual scholarship of up to \$15,000 and/or an annual stipend of \$5,000 for providing direct care services in schools, community-based agencies, and health centers located in Massachusetts.

Selection Process

Once application materials are submitted, they will be reviewed within 2-3 weeks from the date of receipt. Qualified candidates will be invited for an interview to be conducted either in person or via Zoom. All applicants will be contacted via email regarding the status of their application within 4-6 weeks.
