## Joan Mikula

## Doctor of Humane Letters, honoris causa

Over the course of her 35-year tenure with The Massachusetts Department of Mental Health—which culminated in 2015 upon being appointed Commissioner, a position she held until her retirement in 2020—Joan influenced public policy and created pathways toward success for individuals experiencing mental health challenges.

Joan's legacy of commitment, creativity, passion, and advocacy began in New Jersey as a teacher of students with special needs and continued in myriad locales — on the streets of Philadelphia as a probation officer working with young female offenders; within a locked residential facility in New York supporting young heroin addicts; and on Boston's North Shore, as the head of a not-for-profit youth and family agency. Buoyed by an unwavering belief in the individual's potential for change and growth, Joan herself grew to see mental health challenges as common threads at the heart of social injustice and that government policies and practices held the power to make a difference in the lives of individuals, families, and communities.

As a leader in the fight for mental health parity, Joan witnessed sweeping change over the course of three decades. Major practice and policy changes run the gamut from shifting inpatient treatment to community care and creating a Race, Equity, and Inclusion agenda. Today, her advocacy continues at a community level where she is newly active with the Newton Wellesley Hospital Heart, Health and Wellness Council and consults with the Massachusetts Association of Mental Health on the Pediatric Behavioral Health Urgent Care Project.

# Michael Curry

## Doctor of Humane Letters, honoris causa

Michael Curry, Esq. brings more than three decades of experience in civil rights advocacy, health reform and health equity to his role as President and CEO of the Massachusetts League of Community Health Centers, serving over one million patients out of 300+ practice sites across the Commonwealth.

In the early days of the pandemic, Michael was appointed by the Massachusetts Senate to the Health Equity Task Force, which he co-chaired, and by then Governor Baker to the COVID-19 Vaccine Working Group where he gained a reputation for being the equity voice in the room.

Michael's 25+ years of dedicated service to the NAACP culminated in 2021 when the National Board appointed him Administrator for the New England Area Conference, overseeing all branches in Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire and Vermont.

An Adjunct Professor at both New England Law Boston and Suffolk University's Moakley Center and Sawyer School of Management, Michael has received widespread recognition for his leadership and advocacy, including the 2022 Trailblazer Award from the Massachusetts Black Lawyers Association and a 2022 Lifetime Achievement Award from the Massachusetts Nonprofit Network. Recent accolades include being named among Boston's Most Influential Men of Color by Get Konnected! and Boston Magazine's 150 Most Influential Bostonians of 2023.

After earning his BA from Macalester College in St. Paul, Minnesota and his JD from New England School of Law, Michael graduated from the inaugural class of the Executive Leadership Council's Pipeline to Leadership Program. This honorary degree from William James College will be his third.

## Andy Pond

## Doctor of Humane Letters, honoris causa

Andy Pond has served as President & CEO of the Justice Resource Institute (JRI) since 2006. He first joined JRI in 1985, having earned a master's degree in teaching from SUNY Cortland and his bachelor's degree in English from UMass Amherst. He earned a master's degree in social work while honing his skills as a leader at JRI, and focused his early career on adolescents suffering from the effects of complex trauma. After becoming CEO, Pond built a talented management team, further advancing JRI as an agency at the forefront of the social justice movement. His training as an educator, his experience as a clinician, and his ability to explore complex issues through his writing have served him well. At JRI, Pond created and implemented an integrated system of care designed to help children and adults reach their full potential. Under his leadership, JRI's schools, programs and diverse services have experienced significant growth and garnered national attention. A proponent of collaboration, Pond partners with colleges and universities, state government, and advocacy organizations to ensure that the leadership pipeline reflects the talent and diversity of the communities that JRI serves.
